Press Release

The Greater Warren County Drug Task Force, Springboro Police Department, and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office have completed a several month investigation into drug trafficking involving students of Springboro High School, 15-17 years of age. On February 27, 2006, three juveniles, were arrested after a purchase of cocaine occurred in Clearcreek Township, Warren County, Ohio, from these juveniles.

During the course of this drug investigation it was also learned that one of the juveniles had sold a firearm to a convicted felon, who was later arrested by Springboro PD in possession of the weapon. This group was also in the process of attempting to locate a firearm for the undercover officer, when the decision was made to end the investigation.

This drug investigation involved the purchase of marijuana, psilocybin mushrooms, cocaine, and in one instance, bogus LSD. In all, 21 drug trafficking charges are being levied against these juveniles, in addition to the offense of Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity.

This group has represented themselves to be the source of drugs distributed to interested Springboro High School students.
