PRESS RELEASE **April 16, 2010**

On April 15, 2010, at approximately 7AM, the Warren County Drug Task Force executed a search warrant at 7114 State Route 350 in Oregonia, Ohio, concerning a possible methamphetamine lab located on the premises. This was the result of an investigation that has taken place over the past three months that culminated in the search warrant service.

The initial entry was performed by the Warren County Tactical Response Unit, who secured the premises for members of the clandestine lab unit made up of the Warren County Drug Task Force, DEA Dayton Resident Office, Warren County Prosecutor's Office, Miami Valley Crime Lab and the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation.

Four individuals were found on the premises, three adults and one female 16 year old juvenile. Quantities of methamphetamine, numerous anhydrous ammonia tanks, empty packets of pseudoephedrine, and other chemicals commonly used in the manufacture of methamphetamine, were found during the search, along with five firearms.

Information provided during the search is that active methamphetamine production has been taking place at this residence for at least the past two years. No arrests have been made at this time, but charges will be forthcoming as the investigation continues to progress.
